Steps you can take to protect yourself

We advise members of our community to follow the information that Vancouver Coastal Health and the BC Centre for Disease Control are providing.

The best advice is still to:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for 20 seconds

- Cough and sneeze into a tissue or your shirt sleeve rather than your hands and promptly disposing of used tissues in the waste basket or garbage
- Stay home if you are sick and experiencing flu symptoms, particularly a persistent cough and fever.
- The Provincial Government is recommending against all non-essential travel outside of Canada, including to the United States. Effective March 12, anyone who chooses to travel outside of Canada will be asked to stay away from work or school for 14 days upon their return.
- Practice social distancing and avoid contact with people that are visibly ill.
